







Payment of Fees Policy

Rationale

Preschool fees contribute towards the costs of providing each child with a quality preschool program. Fees are not charged for services and items that are funded by the State Government. They are meant to be an affordable contribution. Children will not be excluded from the preschool due to non-payment of fees.
