

WELCOME TO ROOM 24'S ART GALLERY!

In Room 24, we pride ourselves on designing and creating the most amazing art work that is displayed in our very own 'Art Gallery' outside our room. Throughout the year we have been focusing on creating different and unique masterpieces. We will continue to experiment with different artistic techniques and conventions such as colour contrast, patterning, using different materials, creating illusions, shading and more. There is always a key message behind each of our designs and we always look at our artwork with an open perspective. Throughout the design process, we explore famous artists and the meaning behind their artwork. We also explore this with an emphasis on learning more about Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists and the skills and techniques they used to create famous paintings and drawings.

One of our designs focused on using a technique involving fine line art. We learnt about different zodiac signs that were made from different constellations in the Solar System and drew the symbols that match these specific groups of stars. We also worked on displaying colour contrast by highlighting and decorating our zodiac sign using different colours. During the creating process, we focused on our identity and what it means to have a place in our class. We are very proud of our final pieces.
